



Mission Statement

The mission of the South Brunswick Special Education Parent Advisory Group (SB-SEPAG) is to facilitate communication among parents, guardians, community members, school administrators, and the Board of Education in order to provide direct input to administrators on the policies, programs, and practices that affect services and supports for students with special education needs. The SB-SEPAG also offers opportunities to raise questions, voice concerns, and learn about district programs, services, and resources.

The SB-SEPAG is open to all parents and guardians of students in the referral process and receiving special education services from the South Brunswick School District, and the South Brunswick community. The SB-SEPAG promotes inclusion, understanding of, respect for, and support of all children with special education needs in our community.

SEPAGs are required for all school districts in New Jersey. SB-SEPAG is a state-mandated, district-wide volunteer organization. N.J.A.C. 6A:14-1.2(h) states: "Each board of education shall ensure that a special education parent advisory group is in place in the district to provide input to the district on issues concerning students with disabilities."
